

Board Facts Sheet

- Members of the Board are volunteers. Board Members are appointed by the Chief Minister.
- The term of the appointment is 3 years.
- Meetings are generally once a month at 12:30 pm to 1:30 pm, currently the meetings are held on Mondays.
- There is also an expectation that Board members will attend the AGM/Regional Forum and Board Planning Day both of which are held all day on a Saturday
- Meetings are held in Darwin. Remote members may meet by teleconference or occasionally in person, depending on travel budgets and availability
- There are 10 members of the Board including a Chairman, Deputy Chairman, Treasurer.
- The Board is responsible for setting policy and direction for the organisation.
- Sometimes Board members are asked to provide practical assistance like securing donations or giving out flags at events.
- Board Members are asked to attend functions on Australia Day, 26 January and through out the year.
- The Australia Day Council NT Inc. is a not for profit, community based organisation.
- The organisation currently has one paid full-time staff member, the Executive Director and a part-time Administration Officer.
